Joseph and Nellie Vaitulis Scholarship Guidelines

1. The scholarship committee will use the following criteria to award the Vaitulis Scholarship:
 - a. First preference will be given to active participants at Harvest Church, New Hampton
 - b. Additional preference will be given to students whose parents are actively and primarily engaged in farming
 - c. Other factors that may be considered: community service, extra-curricular activities, field of study, and G.P.A.
2. The number of scholarships available will be determined by the Christian Education Board each year, not to exceed a maximum of eight.
3. The scholarship amount may vary from year to year, as scholarships will be taken from the interest available.
4. The scholarship will be paid to the school in which the recipient is enrolled.
5. Students are eligible to receive the scholarship for a total of eight semesters. At the time of the award of the scholarship, the receiver will be expected to write a letter of thanks to Harvest Church for helping to finance this scholarship. Please include in this letter a little information about what classes and activities you are involved in and how school is going. After the first year, students may continue to receive the scholarship by writing a thank you letter to Harvest Church, which is to be given to the Christian Education Board, -no later than June 30th.
6. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) to continue to receive the scholarship. The Christian Education Board will need verification by January 15th for 1st semester G.P.A and June 15th for 2nd semester G.P.A.
